

The first policy issued

The first policy insuring the life of a Michigan resident was issued on October 28, 1845. Mr. William O. Fiske, age 33, of Constantine, was insured by the company for \$2,000. At the time the policy was issued, Mr. Fiske was married and a bookkeeper by occupation.

The first office

The first Michigan Branch Office opened in Detroit in July 1892. In 1902, the Home Branch, later changed to the Griswold Street Branch, and the Chamber of Commerce Branch were also established in Detroit. These two offices were consolidated with the Majestic Branch in 1906. The Grand Rapids Branch was established in 1895.
